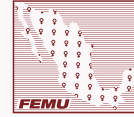

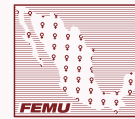
November 29 and 30, 2021

Specialized lectures on the subject will be presented with the aim of making a comprehensive analysis at the national and international level. We invite the national and international community to present their presentation proposals.

Each speaker will have a maximum of 10 to 15 minutes for their presentation. There will be two sessions per day, one from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and another from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. (GMT -5, Mexico City time).

It is necessary for the speakers to have a computer with a camera, microphone, and internet access.

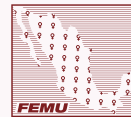

EDITORIAL CRITERIA FOR ARTICLE SUBMISSION

I. The characteristics of the work

All the original papers that are delivered must include the following characteristics:

- 1. The presentation of the work will online to the email femumexico@gmail.com, in a .doc or .docx file created in Microsoft Word. The pages must meet the following characteristics: letter size; one column; Arial 12 point; 1.5 spacing word; margins of 2.5 centimeters superior and inferior of and 3 centimeters in left and right; no spaces between paragraphs, only between the title and the text; between the titles and the sections, and between these and the text.**
- 2. Footnotes will be written in Arial 10-point, single space.**
- 3. All sheets must be numbered.**
- 4. If any, the images used in the work must be send in .jpg or .tif format, which will be placed both within the text of the article and in a separate file indicating its corresponding place in the text.**
- 5. The text of each work must have a minimum of 15 pages and a maximum of 25, including tables, images, and reference sources.**



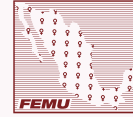

II. Spelling and content

1. The essay must contain a footnote at the beginning with a brief profile of the author of no more than two lines.
2. Those in charge of the editorial processes will respect the style of the authors, which will only be modified when necessary and with their authorization.
3. Abbreviations will be used only in those cases where they are necessary, and the way in which they are used should be clarified in the text itself. When there is a repeated use of abbreviations, the author should elaborate an index of them, as well as their meaning. In the use of acronyms, the same rules must be followed.
4. Words in different languages to the original and Latinisms must be written in italics or italics.
5. The titles of the works, dictionaries, encyclopedias, newspapers, and magazines that are cited in the text must be written in italics, providing the reference sources in the footnotes.
6. Capital letters should be used only for proper names, the full names of the laws or ordinances that are cited.
7. The first line after the title and subtitle, nor the first of the transcripts, will not be indented. While the following first lines must have a centimeter of indentation from the margin.

8. Transcripts that exceed five lines should be put in a separate paragraph, which should have a left indent of two centimeters from the margin. The font size should be 10 points and single spacing.

9. At the end of the paragraph after the period, “enter” will be used and no more space will be left between one paragraph and another.

III. Footnotes and text citations

Footnotes and citations will be made in accordance with the Chicago Style Manual.

V. Delivery deadline:

Title and summary of the presentation: October 30th, 2021.

Full presentation: November 10th, 2021.

In addition, the speaker must send a curricular profile in 10 lines, indicating, preferably:

- Professional training, title and/or academic degrees.
- Institution where she/he works and current position.
- Professional and/or academic trajectory.
- Field and lines of work.
- Publications and distinctions.
- Activities related to the exercise of her/his academic career.
- Email and telephones.
